Abstract

Here is an instruction how to use the files:

1. Download two files: `abstr.cls` and `abstr_inv.tex` to the same directory on your computer. $\text{AMS-L}^{\text{A}}\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$ packages `amssymb`, `amsfonts`, `amsmath` are automatically preloaded. No need to declare them! Do not use any other packages except absolutely required.
2. Open `abstr_inv.tex` file in your favourite $\text{T}_{\text{E}}\text{X}$ -editor. Save it as `lastname_abstr_inv.tex`.
3. Required fields: In the appropriate fields provide title, your first and last name, e-mail, affiliation (name of an institution), AMS Subject Classification symbol.
4. Optional fields: AMS Secondary classification and names of the coauthors, fill out and uncomment, if needed.
5. It is highly recommended to avoid:
 - unnecessary line breaks,
 - long, complicated mathematical formulas and diagrams,
 - changing font type or font size in text,
 - references.
6. Abstract length should range from the 'T'-markers on sides to the 'L'-markers below.
